

EXTRA - CURRICULAR ELIGIBILITY

Extra-curricular activities are understood to be activities sponsored by the school for which a student does not earn credit toward graduation. Activities included are:

- a. Academic Challenge
- b. Cheerleading
- c. Drama
- d. Interscholastic sports
- e. Key Club and other service groups
- f. School publications (literary magazine, newspaper)
- g. Ski Club

If new organizations are proposed, they will be evaluated to determine their status under the policy.

An annual review of school activities affected by eligibility will be made.

Athletes must comply with the academic eligibility requirements of The Ohio High School Athletic Association, and of Lutheran West. Eligibility will be checked for all students at the end of each nine-week grading period. These eligibility requirements state that in order to be eligible, the student:

- a. must be passing a minimum of 5 credits toward graduation
- b. have not more than one failure at the time of the eligibility check
- c. must maintain a 1.5 G.P.A. per quarter
